Superintendent's Report: Angus Wilson

- French immersion Gr 6 (late) will start working through the system and join in with the early phase in the later years
- Accessibility committee needs to meet by next year and will be meeting in short order -Angus to provide details once done
- Hatzic Middle school lock down, call in threat cause (disruption vs threat) vs. hold and secure, phone was pinged in Maple Ridge - no actual threat
- Government announced funding for areplacement of MSS lengthy processes- earliest approximately 2028
 - Granted process, show evidence of our concept/ideas
 - Must find a contractor that works for school board
 - Full approval with \$\$
 - Then a bid of sorts goes out for architectural drawings, etc
 - Stakeholder collaboration / input
 - Scale of MSS is enormous and has an impact on the neighbouring community = traffic flow, sewer lines - already in discussion with city of Mission

AED in schools - update:

- Would love to see tech tools that could change kids lives, on the other side, does not want child to be reliant on cell phones (could be damaging if not used properly)
- Agnus cell phone is a huge challenge, impossible to ban cell phones, he would want to know if a child required a cell phone but did not have access to one
- Tech committee plan and meeting on such topics
- Social media, training, misinformation, photoshop, issues for all levels of school (elementary and up!)
- Send Agnus request for information and questions to be answered on this topic where does DPAC see the different stages on technology
- Apps are sometimes better set up for a phone vs other devices
